Article Submission Guidelines

Following are guidelines for submitting an article to New Accountant magazine:

We publish articles written by college/university professors. As such, the acceptance rate is typically very high as long as the topic is relevant to students.

Topic must be a subject of interest for college students majoring in Accounting and recent grads and written so that it is understood by them.

Word count can be between 800 – 1,750. Anything over that will have to be preapproved, depending on topic and overall length.

Please submit in word document format, double-spaced and should include an intro or abstract page with a brief description of the article, and should include all authors and their respective accreditation, contact information and school/employer information.

References may be included at the end, however may not be published due to space constraints.

If your article contains tables, they MUST be created as graphics files and embedded into the word doc file.

New Accountant is Cabell's listed. Articles in New Accountant can be independently peer reviewed if you notify us in writing you wish have your manuscript go through New Accountant's independent peer review process. This generally takes several months.

When the article passes the peer review process and published, the editor will label the article, in the magazine, as peer reviewed.

Please include a high resolution headshot image of all authors with your article for publication.
